### ABOUT YIS

Yokohama International School (YIS) is an **independent, co-educational pre-K-12 day school** established in 1924. We have a **non-selective admission policy** and do not offer academic scholarships. Our high school programs provide academic **rigour, balance, and challenge** and we celebrate the success of each student individually, independent of the achievements of other students.

### STUDENT BODY AND FACULTY

With students of 54 nationalities and faculty and staff from 18 countries, internationalism is at the heart of our school culture. Approximately 15% of our MS/HS students are new to YIS each year, while the average faculty tenure is eight years. We have 791 students in the Early Learning Center through grade 12. There are 293 students in grades 9-12, and 70 students in the class of 2024.

### SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND DIPLOMA PATHWAYS

**YIS Diploma with full International Baccalaureate Diploma, YIS Diploma with International Baccalaureate Courses, and YIS High School Diploma.**

YIS offers Reggio Emilia-based learning, International Baccalaureate Primary Years (PYP), Middle Years (MYP), and Diploma Programs (IBDP).

### GLOBAL CITIZEN DIPLOMA

The GCD enables students to qualitatively describe their whole learning in the context of becoming a global citizen and making a contribution to the world. By using a process of deliberate reflection, students are required to re-examine their experiences, synthesize their learning, and make sense of their education as they arrive at a deeper understanding of themselves. The GCD is designed to recognize all that students do to learn, in class, in the wider context of school, and in the world beyond. ### STUDENT ENGAGEMENT AND SERVICE LEARNING

Service is an integral part of the learning experience at YIS. It involves our community as leaders, learners, guardians and citizens. Through service we develop empathy, gain knowledge of real needs, enter into mutually beneficial relationships and take action. The athletic program is an important part of a carefully crafted, balanced approach that aims to contribute to students' physical, social and emotional well-being, with students able to participate in over 18 competitive athletic activities.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CLASS OF 2024

The YIS HS Diploma is accredited by NEASC and represents the successful attainment of 23 Carnegie Units.

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### NOTES ABOUT THE YIS TRANSCRIPT

In Grade 11 and 12, **all classes use the IBDP as the organizing framework for content and structure.** This includes classes for students who are not pursuing the IBDP. **YIS does not weight GPA and does not rank students or provide percentile/decile information.** Students are assessed on a 1-7 scale, and GPA is out of 7 accordingly. YIS does not compare IB grades with grading systems from other schools or countries. **Global Citizen Diploma and Diploma with Distinction** achievements may be listed, pending graduation.



A very limited number of YIS students participate in the SAT. As a result we do not maintain data or statistics for the SAT.


